2015 call, for Associate Clinical Investigators

Fellowship Program, starting January 2016,
to provide specialized training of high quality in different areas of **cancer research, clinical or translational.**

The training program must include a stay of 9-12 months at **MD Anderson Cancer Center Houston.**

Candidates: specialists in Pathology, Medical Oncology, Hematology, Radiation Oncology, Surgical Oncology. Specialized Training (MIR) completed in the last three years

Candidates must propose a training program associated with a research project in any of the priority areas of the call:

- Translational Molecular Pathology: developing of molecular-based approaches to cancer diagnosis and management
- Investigational Cancer Therapeutics (Phase I Clinical Trials Program) and personalized advanced cancer therapy

Period: 2 (1+1) years.

Continuity and promotion: interim (after the first year) and final evaluations could give access to a formal faculty position in MDACC Madrid.

Documentation required:

Each application will include:

- Curriculum vitae
- Letter of motivation (one page): including statement of applicant goals
- Letter of recommendation
- Formal Proposal of research project.
- USMLE Certificate (candidates with clinical activities, required).
